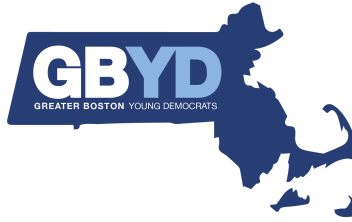


# Greater Boston Young Democrats Board of Directors



## Board. Res. 11 A Process for Dues Hardship Exemption

RESOLVED,

The inability to pay dues which may be established by the Greater Boston Young Democrats will not inhibit the ability of any member to participate in GBYD events, or be a voting member should they seek and obtain a hardship exemption as outlined in the process below:

Any member seeking a hardship exemption will submit a request to such effect in writing to the Chair, stating they cannot make a payment of dues that year due to personal financial burden. The Chair shall submit a recommendation to the Board as to whether the exemption is appropriate and the Board shall vote on the waiver no later than the second meeting after it is received. Any waiver approval which shall be recommended in the affirmative by the Chair shall be undebatable and unamendable.

The Chair will transmit a hardship exemption request to the Secretary and Outreach Director to update the records pertaining to the Register of Voting Members to reflect that the member in question has requested an exemption, pending its approval, and subsequently the same officers shall update the register upon the decision of the Board.

Once the request has been logged in the records pertaining to the Register of Voting Members, the Chair will notify the member that their request has been received and approved.

As part of the notice of approval of any exemption, members will be asked by the Chair to participate in facilitating or supporting a future event held by the Greater Boston Young Democrats.
