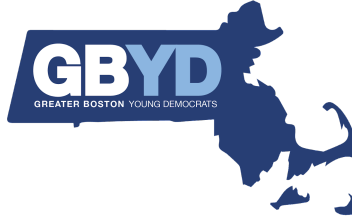


Greater Boston Young Democrats Board of Directors



Board. Res. 17 Call to Convention With Agenda (Spring Local Issues Convention 2022)

RESOLVED,

That the Greater Boston Young Democrats Board of Directors, in fulfillment of Section 4-2 of the Charter hereby calls a GBYD Convention. Such convention shall be called to order at 7 pm on the twenty-sixth day of March, and shall adjourn under the authority of this order no later than 9:30 pm.

FURTHER RESOLVED,

That items eligible for consideration at such convention shall be:

- a. Local Resolutions-in-Convention approved onto the agenda by a further resolution of the Board, not to exceed 15 in aggregate, to be chosen by the Board from among those submitted before 24th March at 5 pm.
- b. Democratic Primary Endorsements for state House and State Senate for candidates for whom the submission of a completed questionnaire has been certified by vote of the Board in the districts named in schedules A and B below.
- c. Endorsement of a Ballot Question *in the affirmative* for the Income Tax for Education and Transportation Amendment (Fair Share Amendment).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that further notifications be given to the convention as to which items qualify under the first section of this resolution as expediently as is possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members appointed to serve on the Convention Rules Committee be Chair Daniel Ernst and members Jack Perenick, Francois Garel Jean-Enard, Adam Mandell, and Katherine Aronson-Ensign.
